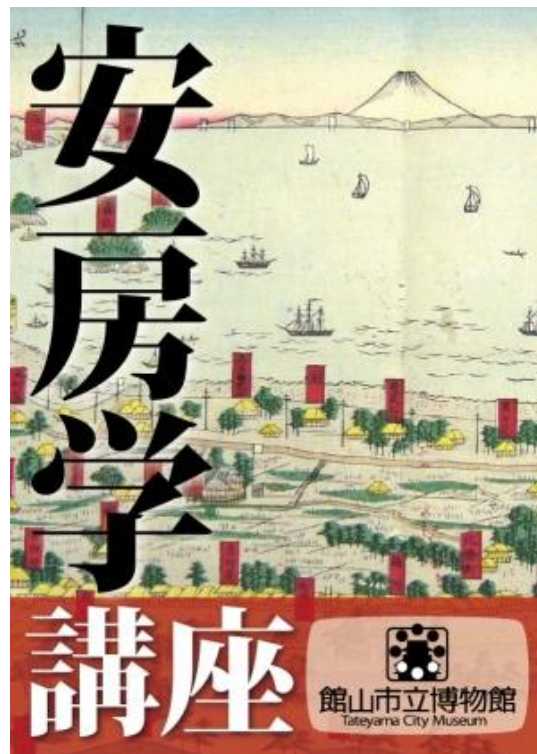

Takabe Shrine Autumn Festival

Takabe is the only shrine in Japan dedicated to the gods of cooking.

The festivals here are famous for their “knife ceremony,” in which a skilled chef prepares various fish with only a knife and chopsticks, never touching the food with his hands. Because this tradition has performed since the Heian period, the practitioners still wear traditional robes and lacquered hats and perform the rite in a solemn atmosphere.

When: The ceremony starts at 11:00 AM (The festival begins at 10:00 AM)
